M&NP Student Award considerations:

M&NP and the Assembly of Nova Scotia Mi'kmaq Chiefs are committed to the development of future generations of Mi'kmaq students through academic and personal development. Our Scholarship and Academic Achievement Awards Program encourages students to set higher goals and provides recognition for their accomplishments.

Who is eligible?

All Students who are:

- registered with a Nova Scotia Mi'kmaq band;
- enrolled either full-time or part-time;
- expectations of returning the following year to their field of study; and
- graduating high school.

What awards are available?

Scholarships of \$1500.00 will be awarded to full-time/part-time students enrolled in a Masters, Doctorate or professional program.

Scholarships of \$1000.00 will be awarded to full-time/part-time students enrolled in University, College, Vocational or Technical Institutes.

Academic Achievement Awards of \$500.00 will be awarded to High School graduating students.

Academic Achievement Awards of \$500.00 will be awarded to students graduating from Adult High School or academic up-grading

How are recipients selected?

An independent selection committee will review and score applications based on academic performance, career goals, leadership, and role model qualities.

Application deadline:

Scholarships - June 17th, 2011 by 4 pm.
Academic Achievement Awards - July 15th, 2011 by 4 pm.

Keys to successful applications:

Line up your references early – before school closes. Consider faculty or advisors from your current academic program who know you well and can provide a valuable recommendation to your application.

Things to include in your essay:

- Highlight accomplishments (grades, awards etc.)
- Volunteer work
- Special circumstances

Ask a friend or colleague to review your personal essay to ensure you are putting your best case forward to our selection committee.

Set an early deadline for yourself to have the application fully completed.

Make sure you enclose all information required.

To be eligible you must submit all of the following information:

- ✓ Application form fully completed and signed.
- ✓ Please write an essay of no more than two pages telling us why you should receive a scholarship or academic achievement award. Explain your educational goals and career plans. Include any awards you have received, community and volunteer work you have done and special school activities in which you participate.
- ✓ Letter of recommendation from a teacher/professor/education counsellor or student advisor.
- ✓ Official transcripts from your current academic year.
- ✓ Proof of acceptance in graduate studies.
