## UNBI Student Awards

Through financial contributions provided by Maritimes Northeast Pipeline and Emera Brunswick Pipeline, UNBI has developed a student award program designed to recognize the exceptional efforts of our members attending post secondary institutions and an award for our students graduating from high school.

The companies and UNBI are committed to the development of future generations of Maliseet and Mi'kmaq youth through personal and academic development. This educational initiative is designed to help youth set higher goals and to recognize and encourage their achievements.

## Who is eligible?

Maliseet and Mi'kmaq students who are a registered member of the UNBI communities and are enrolled as full time students in the current academic year. Priority will be given to those students on the Band nominal role (High School)) and to students being funded through their respective Bands (Post-secondary).

## What awards are available?

High School:

\$500.00 will be awarded to qualifying High school students from the community.

Post Secondary:

\$1000.00 will be awarded to qualifying students from the community enrolled in a university, college, vocational or technical institute.

## To avoid being disqualified, please enclose the following information:

1. Application form fully completed and signed.
2. An essay of no more than two pages telling us why you should receive a scholarship. Explain your educational goals and career plans. Include any awards you have received, community and volunteer work you have done and special school activities in which you participate.
3. Official high school or post secondary institution transcripts from the past year.
4. A letter of reference from a Teacher or Professor.

## Selection Process

An independent selection committee will review and score applications based on Academic performance, career goals, leadership, role model qualities, and financial need.

All successful applicants will be notified upon review of required materials. Successful high school recipients will receive their award at their respective graduation ceremonies, successful post secondary recipients will receive their awards at a special award ceremony, the date and time of which will be included in the award notification letters mailed to successful applicants.
